You should totally sign up now for a program. Go to their website and check out the different programs. Super easy. 🎉

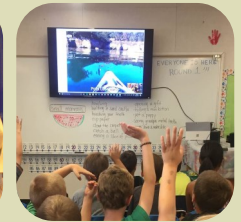
